#### Further guidance on exemption from dual registration regulations

Students can accept an offer of a place from UCL when they are still formally registered with another Higher Education Institution, or if they are re-sitting examinations. However, they may not formally register with UCL until they are no longer registered with another institution, having graduated or left.

#### 1.4.6 Applicants with Disabilities

Applicants who have a disability should inform UCL of this on their application. This will ensure that any special requirements needed, can be put in place.

#### 1.4.7 Applicants Under the Age of 18

UCL will consider for admission to its programmes applicants who will reach the age of 18 during or after their expected period of attendance. If a young applicant is offered a place, UCL has set in place procedures to protect young applicants and young students and the arrangements prescribed will be put in place prior to them enrolling at UCL as a 'young student'.

### 1.4.8 Applicants Transferring from Other Higher Education Institutions

All applicants studying at another higher education institution, including those who wish to transfer to a full-time undergraduate degree programme at UCL, whether to commence a new programme of study, or to enter direct into the second year of a degree programme, must apply through UCAS.
